### Project Hope

Our Grand Master is continuing the project started by M. W. Bro. Donald A. Campbell, to support three prostate cancer **research** projects.

Prostate cancer is the most common cancer among

Canadian men (excluding non-melanoma skin cancers). It is the 3rd leading cause of death from cancer in men in Canada.

According to The Canadian Cancer Society, it is estimated that in 2015:

- ◆ 24,000 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer. This represents 24% of all new cancer cases in men in 2015.
- ◆ 4,100 men will die from prostate cancer. This represents 10% of all cancer deaths in men in 2015.
- ◆ On average, 66 Canadian men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer every day.
- ◆ On average, 11 Canadian men will die from prostate cancer every day
