The Heritage Lodge No. 730 Emergent Meeting

On Tuesday, June 20, somewhere in the middle of The North Atlantic Ocean on board The Queen Mary 2 (Latitude 50°00' N Longitude 020°20' W to be exact), a special Emergent Meeting of The Heritage Lodge No. 730 was held, under dispensation, to help celebrate the 300th anniversary of The United Grand Lodge of England, and the 150th anniversary of the Confederation of Canada. Twenty one Masons attended the meeting. The following Grand Jurisdictions were represented:

The Captain was presented with a plaque commemorating the meeting and both the 300th anniversary of The UGLE and the 150th anniversary of Canadian Confederation.

There generally is a gathering of Masons on every Cunard voyage, but to the best of the Captain and crews knowledge, this is the first time an actual meeting with regalia has been held. As is customary at the Cunard Masonic Gatherings, a collection was made at the conclusion of the meeting. The sum of \$ 245 US, and £ 65 was presented to the captain's secretary on behalf of all present on June 20. The funds were donated to the captain's charity of choice, The Prince's Trust.
